Questions for Lectio for Saturday, October 27: Mark 10:46-52

- 2. What helps you to lessen the effects of the many clashing images that tend to make you fearful or lacking hope for the future? How can the word of God from today's gospel challenge you? Comfort you? Give you hope?
- 3. What is your understanding of ABLED and DISABLED in terms of those called by God to discipleship? How do you think of people with disabilities? Have you ever thought of yourself as abled or disabled?
- 4. How do you pray WITH the suffering of the world, rather than separating the world's suffering from your prayer? (Invitation from Pope Francis)
